2022 Scholarship Application

Zion Baptist Church announces the 2022 Mildred Randle Cook Worthy Scholarship, which seeks to award at least two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to an African American student who has completed at least one semester in an accredited community college, college, or university program, and who will be continuing their undergraduate studies while also being engaged in community service targeting underserved populations. The applicant must be an undergraduate student who is seeking support to continue their college journey. The student already must be accepteded in an accredited undergraduate college program and pursuing their academic studies for the Fall 2022.

Scholarship Guidelines and Priorities

* African American students who are continuing their college education while engaged in serving our underserved communities through community service.

* Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited undergraduate college or university within the United States for the Fall 2022 semester and provide proof of their community service to underserved communities.

* Scholarship funds will be paid August 2022, **to the selected student(s)** upon receiving certification of enrollment for the Fall 2022 semester, which must include student ID and proof of enrollment from the student's Registrar or Office of Enrollment Management.

* Applications must be received by the Zion Baptist Church College Ministry, no later than May 14, 2022.
